- Preparation for art university entrance examinations: basic sketching, two-dimensional composition, portfolio creation guidance, etc.


9. Payment instructions for School expenses etc.

Please pay the enrollment fee, tuition, facility fees, and other fees after the Certificate of Eligibility (COE) is issued. We will send you the original copy of the Certificate of Eligibility (COE) form after confirming your payment.
After entering school, when changing your (applicant) status of residence or renewing your visa period of stay, you will need to provide proof of remittance as recorded in your bank account, so please make sure to remit living expenses, tuition, and other expenses on a regular basis.
In general, tuition fees, and some parts of the school expenses once paid, will not be refunded. In the case that a student is unable to come to Japan for a justifiable reason, a consultation will be arranged.
